The following information should be provided to the individual writing the letter of recommendation. Be sure and keep a copy.

- Date
- Your Name, Address and Phone Number
- Name of individual from whom the letter is requested
- Courses taken & final grades (if letter is requested from a teacher/counselor)
- GPA (if letter is requested from a teacher/counselor)
- Academic honors you have received
- Activities you have participated in and any offices held
- Community activities in which you have participated
- Any other special achievements/awards?
- Part-time and/or summer employment
- Will you need financial assistance in college?
- Why does this individual think you are a good college candidate?
- To whom should this letter be addressed?
