

# NM MESA COVID19 ACTION-RESPONSE PLAN 2020-2021 School Year

## <u>Scenario</u>

Social Distancing has contained the spread of COVID-19. Schools start on schedule.

### <u>Goal</u>

**1.** Safety first as guided by the NM Dept of Health. 2. Getting recrutiment in as quickly as possible to get students registered. Before the anticipated spike of COVID-19 cases occurs. 3. Have activities set for fall semester since much was missed at the end of the spring semester 2020. to include field trips that follow safety measures if allowed by school districts. 4. Conduct Site Visits and hold RAMS. 5. Rescources, and Supplies will still be supported regionally and for statewide events. 6. One to two virtual statewide events (College Virtual tours, college prep, financial aid resource workshop, meet with recruiters) will occur in the fall. Plan for possible fall MESA event to make up for missed MESA Day 2020. PLan for MESA Day 2021.

## **Action Plan**

**1.** Have sanitation stations set up at in-person and create NM MESA logo face masks or have disposable face masks available to hand out if participants do not arrive with their own mask.

**2.** Each Region has Registration Packets (A1, A2, A3) pre-printed and set to mail/deliver to teachers or mail directly to students. Get MOUS out and back now. Modify to state following numbers of students in class or club would follow all COVID -19 Dept. Of Health Guidelines.

**3.** Activities include keeping all COVID-19 response resouces created in March-May 2020. Having activites, workshops and field trips set ahead of time. All COVID19 response resources created in March-May 2020 will remain a part of the MESA program 2020-2021: Grab-n-Go Packets, Virtual Workshops and Webinars and Online Lessons.

 a. Modify MOU to meet COVID-19 safety guidelines. Send out May-June 2020 and request return by August 2020.
 b.create STEM uniform activity kits that can be dispersed in each

region if an educational community elects to get kits as part of their resources. (kits - engineering and/or science)

**4.** Each Region will asses and follow NM Dept of Health COVID-19 safety guidlines and school district guidelines for in person RAMS and Site Visits. Virtual site visits and RAMS will be held if necessary or to the descretion of the teacher, district and regional coordinator.

**5.** Regional Coordinators will conduct advisor (teacher) surveys to asses what resources and materials are needed in each MESA educational community that can be supported by the regional budget. Materials will be delivered or mailed out as necessary.

**6.** Statewide events will coordiante with local universities to set up these events. Regional coordinators will assist in dissemnation of the information and recruitment for attendance.

Social Distancing has made promising inroads but has not contained the spread of COVID-19 to the level for school to start on schedule.

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#### **STAFF Definitions and Actions**

Sanitation Stations are comprised of hand sanitizer, disposable gloves and resuable or disposable face masks.

Flexible Activity Fund. Checks for schools that will provide accounting to MESA at the end of the year for activity funds used. Amazon shopping lists for advisors(teachers) who wish to utilize activity funds through MESA. Ling will look into logistics of Gift Cards and the accounting logistics for audit purposes for use in Activity Funds.
